



REALTOR® University Scholarships

Applicants may apply for scholarships during the Master of Real Estate (MRE) admissions process and should work with their admissions advisor to do so. These are individual scholarships based on merit, academic excellence and career potential. Unlike loans, scholarships are funds that you do not have to pay back.

Basic Scholarship Eligibility

To qualify for a REALTOR® University scholarship, students must meet all of the following criteria. Students may also be required to meet additional criteria.

- Students must have applied for admission to the REALTOR® University Master of Real Estate (MRE) program
- Students must have met REALTOR® University entrance requirements and be admitted too and enrolled in the Master of Real Estate (MRE) program

General Scholarship Policies

- Scholarship recipients are responsible for all other educational expenses
- To qualify for scholarship funds, students must maintain continuous enrollment on a semester basis.
- Students eligible for multiple special tuition rates, pricing programs or scholarships receive the one most beneficial

Scholarship recipients are expected to meet certain continuing eligibility criteria and progress in a timely manner toward completing their program. To retain scholarship eligibility, recipients must remain in good academic standing.

Scholarship Requirements

Open to all graduate students who meet the following criteria:

- REALTOR® University student
- Submit a completed scholarship application
- Three letters of recommendation from an employer, former teacher or advisor (cannot include family members)
- Submit a 500 word essay or less on "How do you believe a REALTOR® University Master of Real Estate (MRE) degree will help you succeed and meet your career goals?"
- Copy of your official undergraduate transcript
- Copy of applicant resume

Award amount

\$750 per course (program maximum per student of \$9,000)

Continued eligibility

Applicants must maintain no less than a 3.0 grade point average and be continuously enrolled to maintain their scholarship

Scholarship Selection

The REALTOR® University Board of Regents will refer scholarship applications to the Scholarship Committee for their evaluation and recommendation. An interview with the scholarship committee may be required. The Board of Regents will approve the scholarship grant.

Scholarship Funding

All scholarships made through REALTOR® University Scholarship Fund shall be paid directly to REALTOR® University on behalf of the recipient. Availability of scholarships are subject to change.
